Player Code of Conduct

All players are expected to honor the Lord on and off the court. Players should remember that they represent God, their family, their teammates and the HSRC Sports program. We want players who win graciously and are graceful when they lose. We want players who are responsible, disciplined and do their best – results are secondary. All players are expected to:

- Attend every practice and every game. If a player cannot make a practice or game, he/she must contact the coach. The coach reserves the right to apply consequences for excused or unexcused absences.
- Be on time, dressed, and ready to practice at the starting time of practice. If a player will be late, he/she must contact the coach. The coach reserves the right to apply consequences for excused or unexcused tardiness.
- Be at games at least thirty minutes before starting time.
- Participate in all elements of the practice fully and without criticism.
- Graciously accept and respect decisions made by those in authority, including coaches and officials. If a player has concerns with a coach's decision, he/she should meet with the coach privately after the game or practice.
- Ride with the team, both to and from road games, if team transportation is arranged.
- Encourage your teammates, do not demean or ridicule them.
- Respect your opponents, trash talk is not acceptable.
- Accept and adhere to policies and rules instituted by individual coaches (coaches may have additional rules regarding dress, time for getting to games, etc.)
- Be responsible for wear and care of his/her uniform

Coaches may have additional rules for their particular team. Signing of this agreement signifies that the athlete agrees to those rules as well.
